Dear Health Plan Administrator,

On <u>November 30, 2023</u>, NYS notified Plans of the intent to formally implement the Mobile Crisis and Crisis Residence program and billing changes to effectuate the Crisis Intervention State Plan Amendment (SPA) for adults and children on March 1, 2024.

This memo serves as notice to Medicaid Managed Care Plans (MMCPs) that the date to *retire* children's Crisis Intervention Mobile Crisis rate codes (7906-7910; 7936-7942) and Crisis Residence rate codes (7943-7945) has been **extended from March 1, 2024 to May 1, 2024**. **This extension does not change any other requirements as outlined below.** MMCPs already submitted attestations regarding this implementation. There is no need to resubmit.

Please note that as a result of the rate code consolidation, MMCPs and providers should follow the billing logistics outlined in the memo linked above. The Federal Information Processing Standards (FIPS) code and a proxy locator code requirement (see <u>guidance</u>) will no longer be applicable for children's Mobile Crisis billing effective May 1, 2024.
