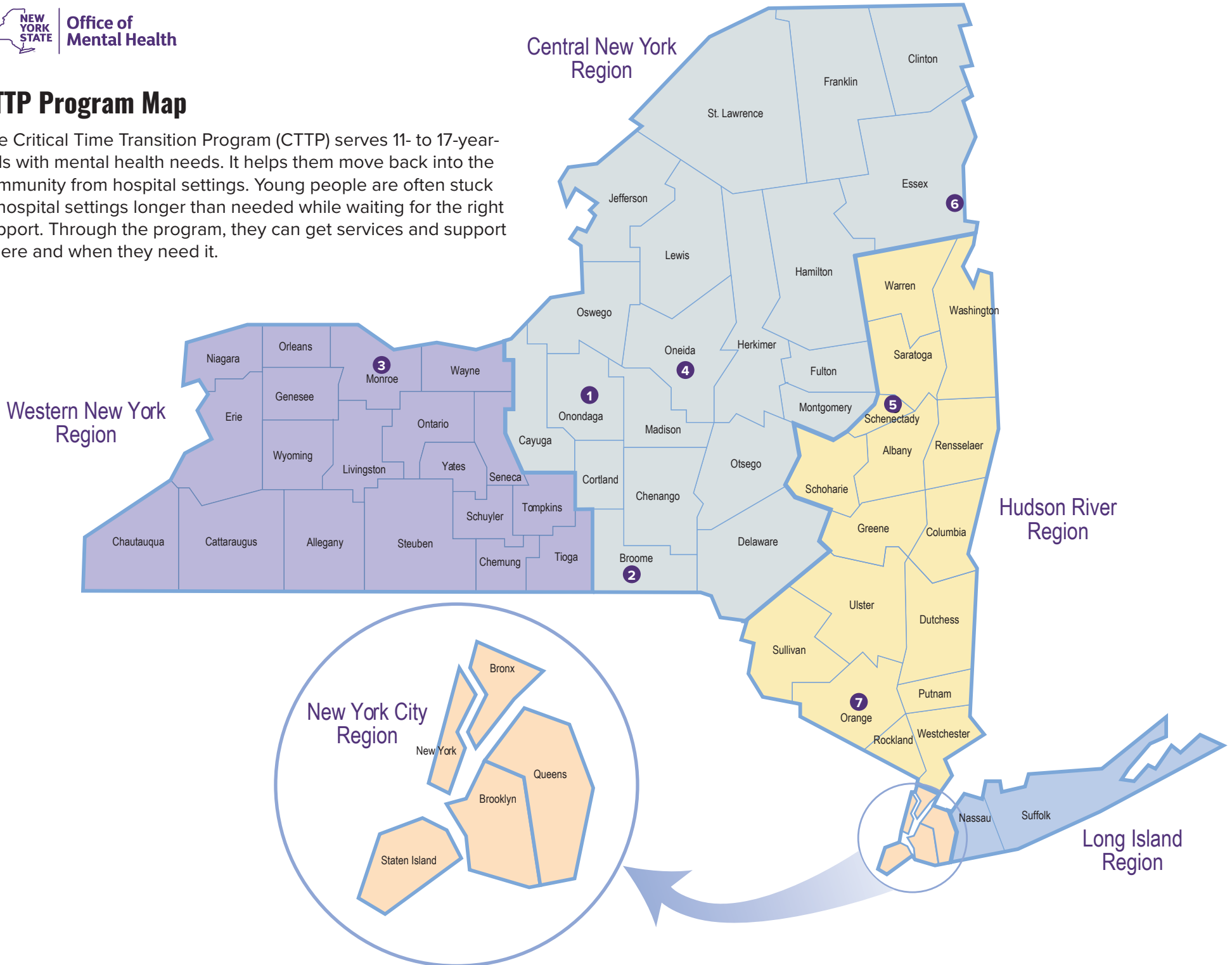


CTTP Program Map

The Critical Time Transition Program (CTTP) serves 11- to 17-year-olds with mental health needs. It helps them move back into the community from hospital settings. Young people are often stuck in hospital settings longer than needed while waiting for the right support. Through the program, they can get services and support where and when they need it.
