1 What do you like about the idea of EMR/HER?

- Portability/Convenience
- Gives Doctors current information
- Brings specialties together
- Removes need for “ritual questions”
- Puts client in more control
- Providers are aware of interactions and side effects
- Better collaboration between doctors and the person
- Doctors can collaborate

2 What do we dislike about EMR/HER?

- Cannot selectively disclose
- Potential Glitches
- Personal information may be brought up by providers that you don't want to know that part of your record
- Information may be made available to someone planning a lawsuit
- Who sees “electronic” fingerprint? Will we be notified when someone looks at our information?
- What happens when we “age out”?
- Privacy: Do all providers need to know all information?
- Will criminal system records be revealed?
- Privacy and security of Internet is questionable
- This may lead to “Police State”
- Potential for discrimination
- Too easy to access
- Cookies on computers
- May hinder anti-stigma
- Don't trust the Internet
