## Introduction

The Butler Recovery and Treatment Center is a clinic service that provides a broad range of mental health services to meet the needs of adults with a diagnosis of mental illness.

We take a person-centered holistic approach to recovery. We are not just treating an illness. Rather, we work with individuals to rebuild a foundation which will sustain lasting recovery and an improved quality of life.

## Our Services

We provide supportive programming in the areas of individual, group, and family counseling, medication management and education, skill building, health and wellness, self help, and peer support.

Vocational services can provide a path to recovering a life role as a worker assist individuals with applying for entitlement programs, enrolling in GED and other educational programs, building resumes, developing job readiness skills, researching volunteer opportunities, and re-entering the workforce.

Connections to other community resources are provided as needed.



## Location/Hours of Operation

Butler RTC is located at 400 Forest Ave. in the Butler Rehabilitation Center where our Elmwood Wellness Center and our peer-run Center for Self Discovery are also located.

The site is handicapped accessible, has ample parking, and is on public transportation routes. For those unable to take public transportation, assistance is provided to help with transportation linkages.

Butler RTC is open from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday; 8 a.m. to 7 p.m. Tuesday.

Rapid access (walk-in) appointments are available.
