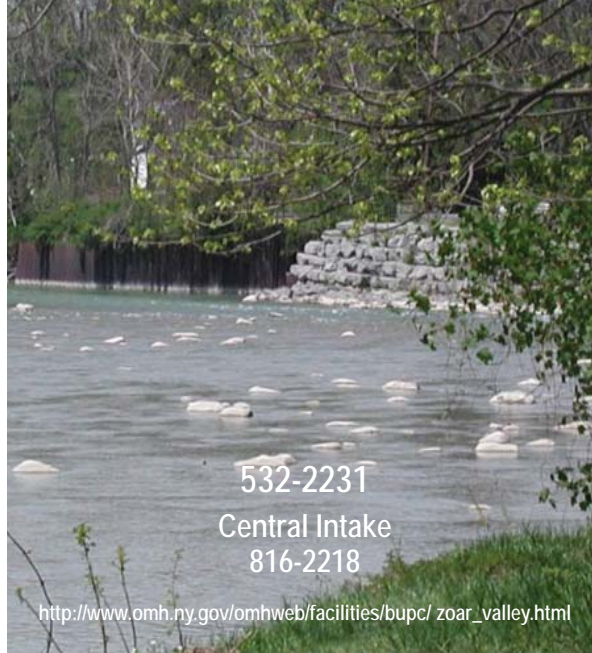
Our Goal

Treatment services are person-centered based on individual needs and choice.

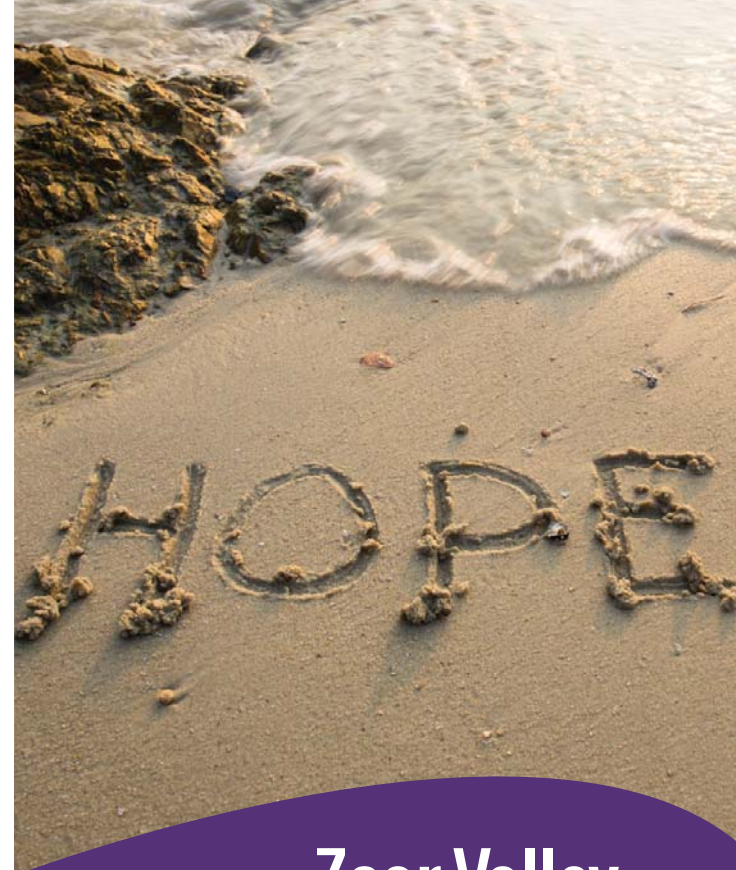

Introduction

Zoar Valley Clinic provides a broad range of mental health services to meet the needs of adults with a diagnosis of mental illness.

We take a person-centered holistic approach to recovery. We are not just treating an illness. Rather, we work with individuals to rebuild a foundation which will sustain lasting recovery and an improved quality of life.

Our Services

We provide supportive programming in the areas of individual, group, and family counseling; medication management and education; skill building; and health and wellness.

Vocational services can provide a path to recovering a life role as a worker. We assist individuals with applying for entitlement programs, enrolling in high school equivalency and other educational programs, building resumes, developing job readiness skills, researching volunteer opportunities, and re-entering the workforce.

We offer the services of a Mobile Integration Team and a Health Home Care Management Team. Staff offices for our Family Care team are also located here.

Connections to other community resources are provided as needed.

Fees

No one is refused service due to inability to pay.

Location/Hours of Operation

Located in Cattaraugus County, we provide a combination of diagnostic and treatment services for individuals with mental illness who reside in the tri-county area of Chautauqua, Cattaraugus, and Erie Counties.

Zoar Valley Clinic is located just off the village main street in a brand new building at 49 S. Water St.

The site is handicapped accessible and has ample parking. For those with transportation needs, staff is able to assist in exploring community-based options.

Zoar Valley Clinic is open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m. Monday, and 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Tuesday-Friday. Rapid Access (walk-in) services are available.

After hours support is available seven days a week by calling our main number, 532-2231. Your call will be automatically forwarded to Crisis Services Inc. counselors who can provide needed assistance. Our staff will provide outreach and followup the next business day.
