

Algorithms and Level of Care (LOC) Determination

- Criterion 1** 1 Child/Youth Behavioral Health Dimension rated 3 and/or the Adjustment to Trauma Domain (Exclude the individual dimension items) rated 3
or
2 or more Child/Youth Behavioral Health Dimension rated 2 and/or the Adjustment to Trauma Domain (Exclude the individual dimension items) rated 2.
- Criterion 2** 1 Child/youth risk behaviors Domain rated 3
or
2 or more Child/Youth Risk behaviors Domain rated 2
- Criterion 3** (Specific to Community Residence (CR) 1 Primary Caregiver Domain items (Supervision, Care Involvement OR Safety) rated 3
- Criterion 4** 2 or more Primary Caregiver Domain rated at least 2 but not meeting criteria 3
or
Child/Youth Life Functioning Domain: a rating of 2 in either Primary Caregiver or Living Situation
- Criterion 5** 1 Child/Youth Risk Behaviors Domain rated 2
- Criterion 6** 1 or more Caregiver capacity rated at least 2
- Criterion 8** (Specific to Residential Treatment Facility (RTF) At least 4 of the following items must be rated 3(School Behavior, School Achievement, School Attendance, Runaway, Intentional Misbehavior, Living Situation and Social Functioning).
- Meet criteria 1, 2, 3 and 8** **(RTF)** Intensive MH services within a very structured treatment and school setting. (Unable to meet child’s needs in the community)
- Meet criteria 1, 5, and 3** **(CR)** Community residence (child needs structured community supportive setting. This level is designed for youth with behavioral and functional challenges who have the ability to engage in community based supports)
- Meet criteria 1, 2, and 4** **(Home and Community Based Services (HCBS) WAIVER)** Intensive community Home Based supports. Child and family require intensive level of multi-services within the home for youth at risk for hospitalization

Meet criteria 1, 5, and 6

(Intensive Case Management (ICM) and Blended Case Management (BCM) Intensive outpatient community supports: Child and family require support to actively engage and link with services within the community (Intensive Case management: ICM, BCM)

Meet criteria 1

(Supported Case Management (SCM) Intensive Supportive Management. Child and family require minimal level of support in engaging and utilizing community supports
