

PSYCKES-Medicaid Release Notes – Release 6.7.1

Medication Assisted Treatment for OUD (MAT-OUD) Filter

A new filter option called "Medicaid Assisted Treatment for OUD (MAD-OUD)" is available in Recipient Search in the "Psychotropic Drug Class" filter. This filter identifies the number of clients who had at least one prescription for medication treatment for OUD in the selected report timeframe (default timeframe is 1 year). MAT for OUD has special data protections; therefore, clients who meet criteria for this filter will only be listed in the results page if they have a PSYCKES consent with that organization. Without client consent, only the aggregate number of clients who had MAT will be displayed. The following medications are considered MAT for OUD for the purpose of this filter:

- Buprenorphine and Buprenorphine HCL
- Buprenorphine HCL-Naloxone HCL
- Naltrexone and Naltrexone HCL

New York State of Health (NYSoH) Enrollment Filters & Messaging

Two new filter options are available in Recipient Search in the "Population" filter to identify specific Medicaid enrollees who must recertify their Medicaid using the New York State of Health (NYSoH) system instead of the WMS system. These filters break-out the clients identified for NYSoH enrollment into two categories:

- Medicaid Recertification Due < 3 months: NYSoH Enrollment Required
- Medicaid Recertification Expired: NYSoH Enrollment Required

Additionally, the client-level Clinical Summary will show the below message for any clients who are identified for recertification in the NYSoH system; the client's Medicaid recertification/expiration date will be included in the message:

"Medicaid Eligibility Alert: This client must use the New York State of Health (NYSoH) enrollment system for Medicaid recertification (expiration: <<date of Medicaid recertification/expiration>>)

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
