

Readmissions Quality Collaborative

Emergency Departments Monthly Reporting Questions

1. Number of Emergency Department (ED) visits during the previous calendar month
2. Potential Readmissions: Number of Emergency Department visits during the previous calendar month by individuals known to have been discharged from behavioral health inpatient treatment within the prior 30 days (i.e., potential readmissions)
3. Actual Readmissions: Among those identified as potential readmissions (discharged from behavioral health inpatient treatment within 30 days prior to ED visit), the number for whom the disposition was to readmit for inpatient treatment
4. Number of individuals identified during the previous calendar month as being eligible for any project intervention
5. Number of individuals who received any project intervention during the previous calendar month
6. **Selected Strategies:** Emergency services have the option to report on one or more strategies to reduce readmissions, selected from the list provided by the collaborative. For each selected strategy:
 - Number of individuals who received [**selected project intervention**] during the previous calendar month
7. **Enhanced Discharge Planning Process(es):** Emergency services are required to report on one or more enhanced discharge planning process being implemented as part of the current readmissions project. Each service defines the discharge process(es) it will implement and report on. (Note: Some of the collaborative's 9 "strategies to reduce readmissions" will satisfy this requirement).

For each discharge process:

Optional: Additional discharge planning process being implemented (if any):

Briefly define additional enhanced discharge planning process being integrated into on-going operations and tracked monthly as part of the current readmissions project (if any).

Number of individuals for whom this discharge process was performed during the previous calendar month
