

PSYCKES-Medicaid Release Notes – New Quality Measures

My QI Report, Statewide Reports, and Recipient Search MH Performance Tracking Measure Set

New quality indicators have been added to My QI Reports, Statewide Reports, and Recipient Search within the existing MH Performance Tracking Measure set. These indicators are calculated on “mature” Medicaid data after a 6-month billing data maturation period to allow for services to be invoiced. The list of new measures within the MH Performance Tracking Measure set are listed below with a brief description.

MH Performance Tracking Measure Set	Description
No Engagement after MH Inpatient	The percentage of individuals ages 6 to 64 years identified as having an acute inpatient discharge with a primary diagnosis of mental health or intentional self-harm, who did not receive five or more follow-up visits with a community-based mental health care provider within 90 days after discharge.
No Intensive Care Management after MH ED Visit	The percentage of individuals ages 21 to 64 years identified as having high mental health needs (e.g., Health Home Plus (HH+) eligibility, Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) enrolled, or Critical Time Intervention (CTI) service use in any of the three months prior to an emergency department (ED) or Comprehensive Psychiatric Emergency Program (CPEP) admission), who were discharged after a mental health ED or CPEP admission who did not receive high intensity care management services in the calendar month following discharge (e.g., HH+, ACT, or CTI service).
No Intensive Care Management after MH Inpatient	The percentage of individuals ages 21 to 64 years identified as having high mental health needs (e.g., Health Home Plus (HH+) eligibility, Assertive Community Treatment (ACT) enrolled, or Critical Time Intervention (CTI) service use in any of the three months prior to an inpatient (IP) admission), who were discharged after a mental health inpatient admission who did not receive high intensity care management services in the calendar month following discharge (e.g., HH+, ACT, or CTI service).
