**Q1. I would like to be clear that for Teams that will be awarded where more than one County is included in the award, it is the bidder's option whether or not to include an additional county(ies) to be served other than the County where the hospital is located? If the bidder does include another County, does it obligate the bidder to follow-through? It may be practical to serve persons located along the shared border, but highly impractical to serve persons located on the opposite border.**

A1. The CTI Team must partner with a hospital(s) in a region/county listed in the RFP. The CTI Team location and main service area should be based on the bolded county where the partner hospital(s) is located. For the region selected, the applicant will identify the county(ies) where the CTI Team intends to provide services, based on the capacity and needs of the team. If the awardee chooses to list other counties served in their proposal, OMH will expect to see those counties in the workplan for the contract.
