**Q1. To apply for this grant does the organization have to be a 501c3?**

A1. Eligible applicants are organizations that currently operate training and technical assistance programs funded by the Office of Mental Health. Current funded training and technical assistance programs can be found here: <https://omh.ny.gov/omhweb/planning/training-for-providers/>

**Q2. Can the applicant be a state agency/hospital?**

**Q3. Who is eligible to apply for the grant? Does the organization have to be a not-for-profit or nonprofit organization?**

**Q6. The RFP states that training materials become the property of OMH. Does this apply to preexisting materials not developed with these contract funds but used in the technical assistance provided through the contract?**
